Our doctors strongly recommend that ALL patients have a thorough examination of their retina every year. **\*\*\*Without the OPTOMAP or a dilated examination, we cannot fully assess the health of your eye\*\*\*** There is an additional fee of \$29.00 for the OPTOMAP. This procedure is NOT covered by insurance. **Dilation may still be required.**

Please note: for **DIABETIC** exams, you will be dilated AND have the optomap photos taken. The optomap photos will be billed to your medical insurance.
